

Knitted Easter Bunnies

(to fit over a Creme Egg)

You will need:

Double knitting wool
Pair of needles UK size 11
Black thread for eyes, nose & mouth
Length of wool for tail
Toy filling
Coloured ribbon to finish off



Check your finished

bunny with a Creme Egg

- it shouldn't drop out

when you pick up the bunny by the head! Add

a couple of extra stitches

if required.

- 1. Cast on 26 sts
- 2. Knit 1 row
- 3. Increase in 1st st, K1, inc. in next st, then every 3rd st until 2sts, K1, inc in last st. (36st)
- 4. Knit 11 rows
- 5. Cast off 1st at beg of next 4 rows (32 sts)
- 6. Cast off 6sts at beg of next 2 rows (20 sts)
- 7. Increase 1 st at beg of next 4 rows (24 sts)
- 8. Knit 4 rows
- 9. K2 then K2tog to last 2sts, K2 (14 sts)
- 10. Knit 4 rows
- 11. K2 then K2tog to last 2sts, K2 (9 sts)
- 12. Draw wool through rem stitches and pull tight
- 13. Sew with that piece of wool round the edge of work to the beg stitch, leaving the cast on edge open so that egg can be inserted
- 14. Stuff the head with toy filling, sew around neck and gather in tight, fasten off

EARS (knit 2)

1. Cast on 8 sts (leaving a long length of wool to sew ear to head)

- 2. Knit 12 rows
- 3. K3 K2tog K3 (7 sts)
- 4. K3 K2tog K2 (6 sts)
- 5. K2 K2tog K2 (5 sts)
- 6. K2 K2tog K1 (4 sts)
- 7. K1 K2tog K1 (3 sts)
- 8. K1 K2tog (2 sts)
- 9. K2tog
- 10. Fasten off, cut wool and sew in end of yarn.
- 11. Fold ears in half lengthways and using the length of attached wool sew on towards back of head starting about 3-4 rows from the top and meeting down centre back of head

TIP - Before cutting yarn from sewing on 2nd ear, sew a few stitches through both ears lengthways and pull tight. This helps to shape the bunny's head and hold ears together

- 12. Embroider nose, mouth and eyes. Slightly pulling thread between the eyes helps to draw in and shape the head. Add a tail (lazy daisy stitch flower with a French knot centre works well)
- 13. Tie a ribbon around neck
